NMRC participants also take advantage of the other classes and programs offered at Portland Adult Education and by community partners.

NMRC OFFERINGS

For Job Seekers

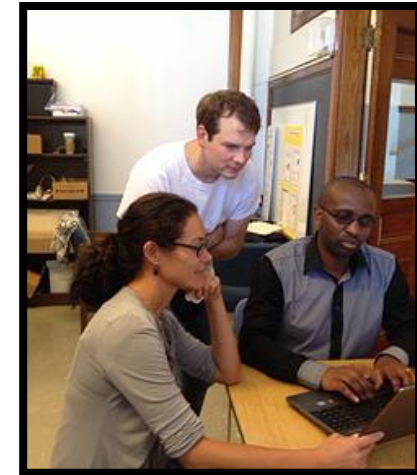
Skilled Professional Program
